

Editor Honorarium Policy

ActiveHistory.ca supports the work of historians practicing in diverse settings and contexts. Recognizing that this often means members of our community have access to vastly different resources, the editorial collective commits to supporting the work of editors, and frequent contributors, without access to institutional financial or administrative assistance, with honoraria of \$150 as well as providing limited financial support to attend events related to Active History. For the purposes of this policy, frequent contributors are considered to be authors who write for the website at least six times per year or do a similar amount of work on the project; editors are considered as members of the Editorial Collective or guest editors of theme weeks or series. Due to limited resources, an individual may only receive an honorarium once in a calendar year, and the editorial collective reserves the right to decrease the honorarium in years when there are limited funds in our account. Honorariums will be issued annually in September. Once all honoraria have been issued, the remainder will be used to support travel during the upcoming year. We will work to increase the honoraria in proportion to our income from donations.
